on a rainy day or for anytime!

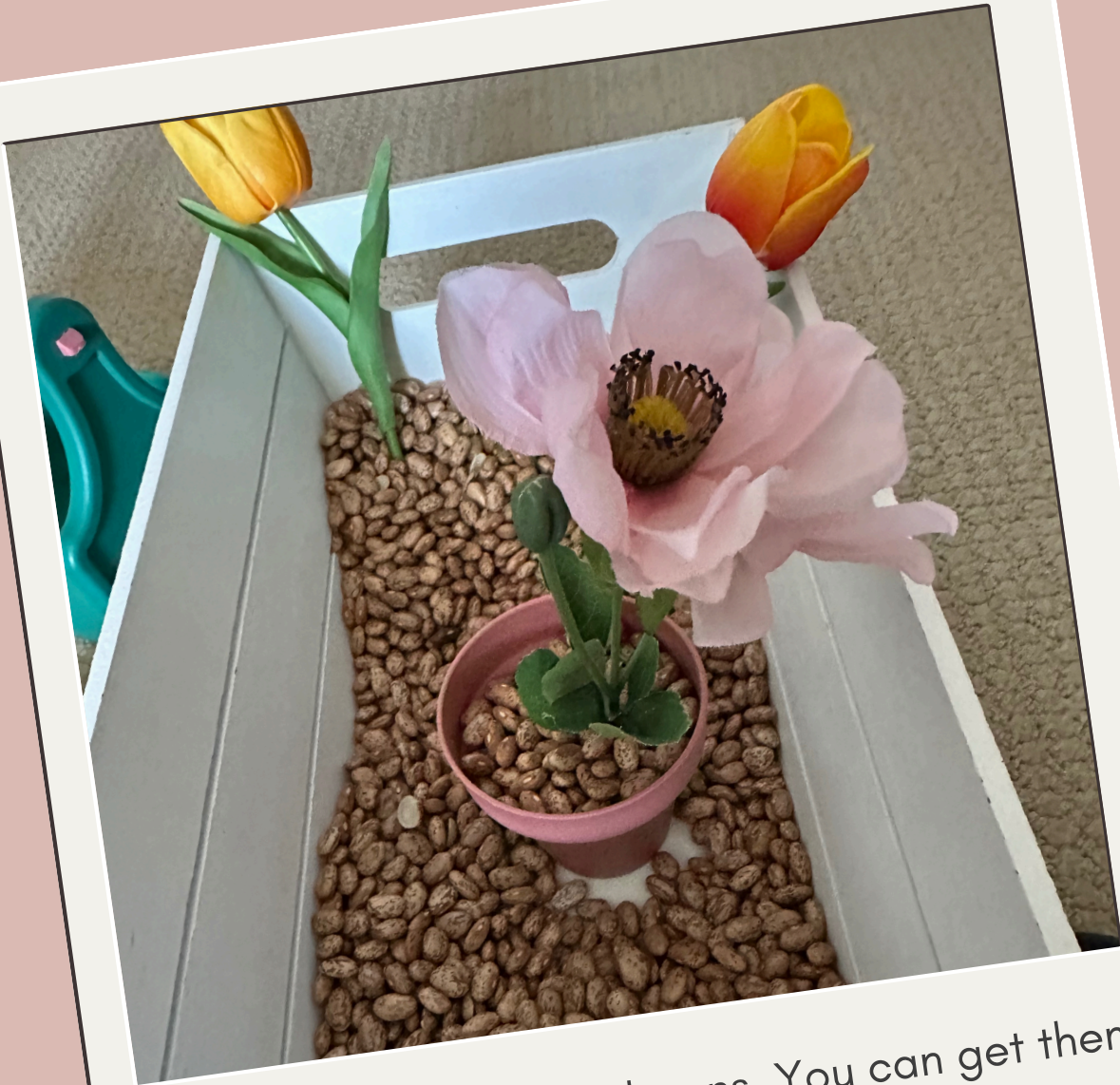
STEP 1: Find A Bin.

These are dried pinto beans. You can get them at any grocery store. Depending on the size of your bin, you may want 2 bags or more.

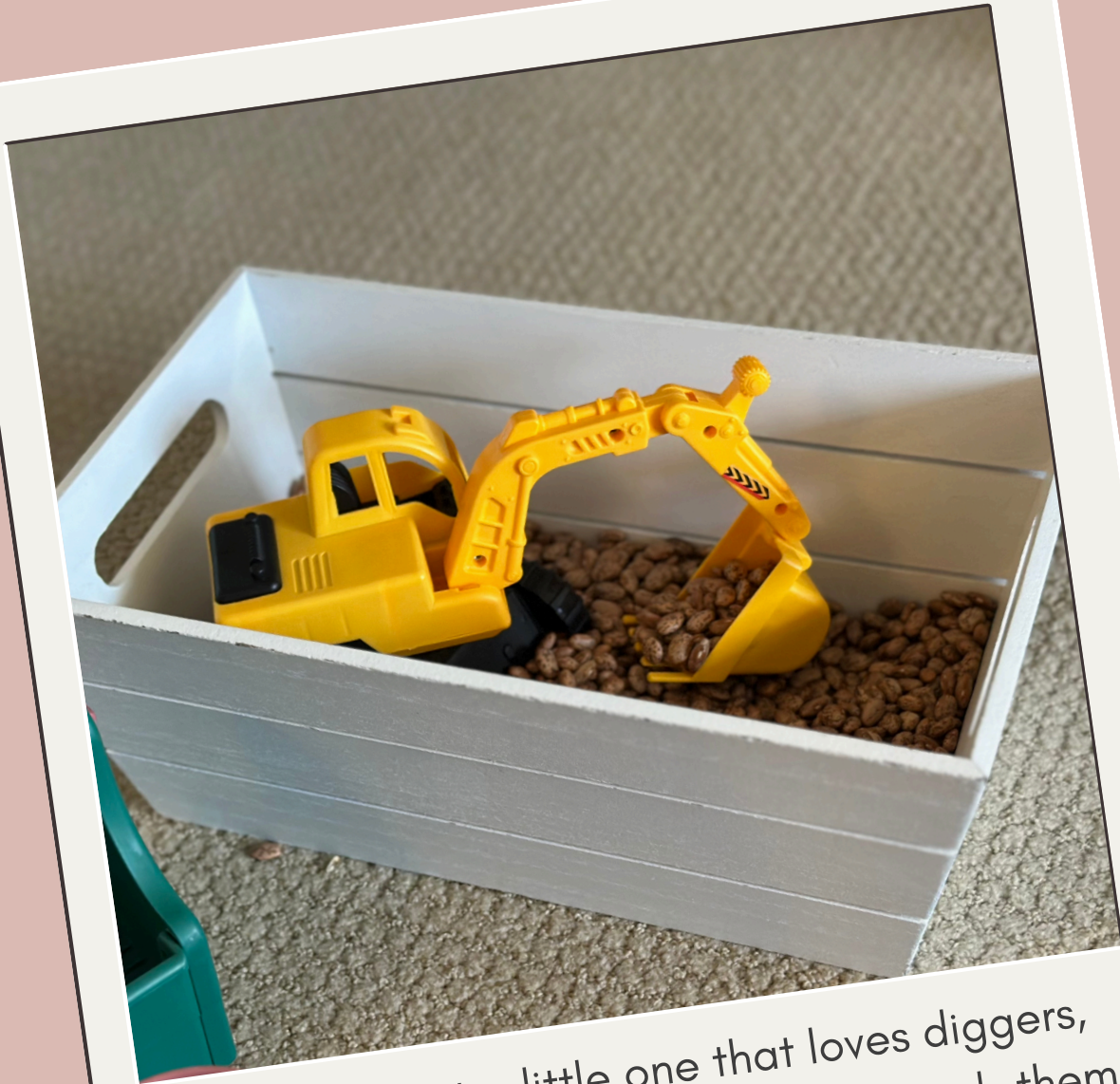
STEP 3:
