Shamrock Twirler

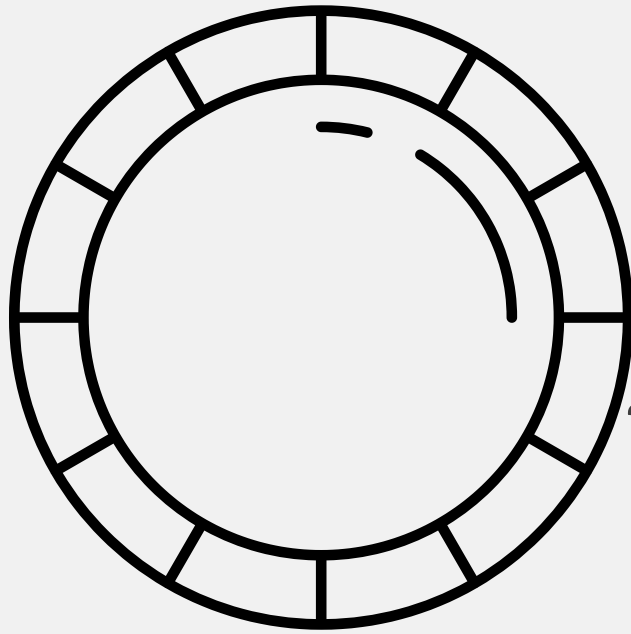

Supplies

- Paper Plate
- Shamrock template (included)
- Green paint or markers
- Paintbrush
- Pencil
- Scissors
- Construction paper
- Glue
- Hole punch
- String

Step 1



Color or paint your paper plate green.

If you paint it, let one side dry before painting the other side.



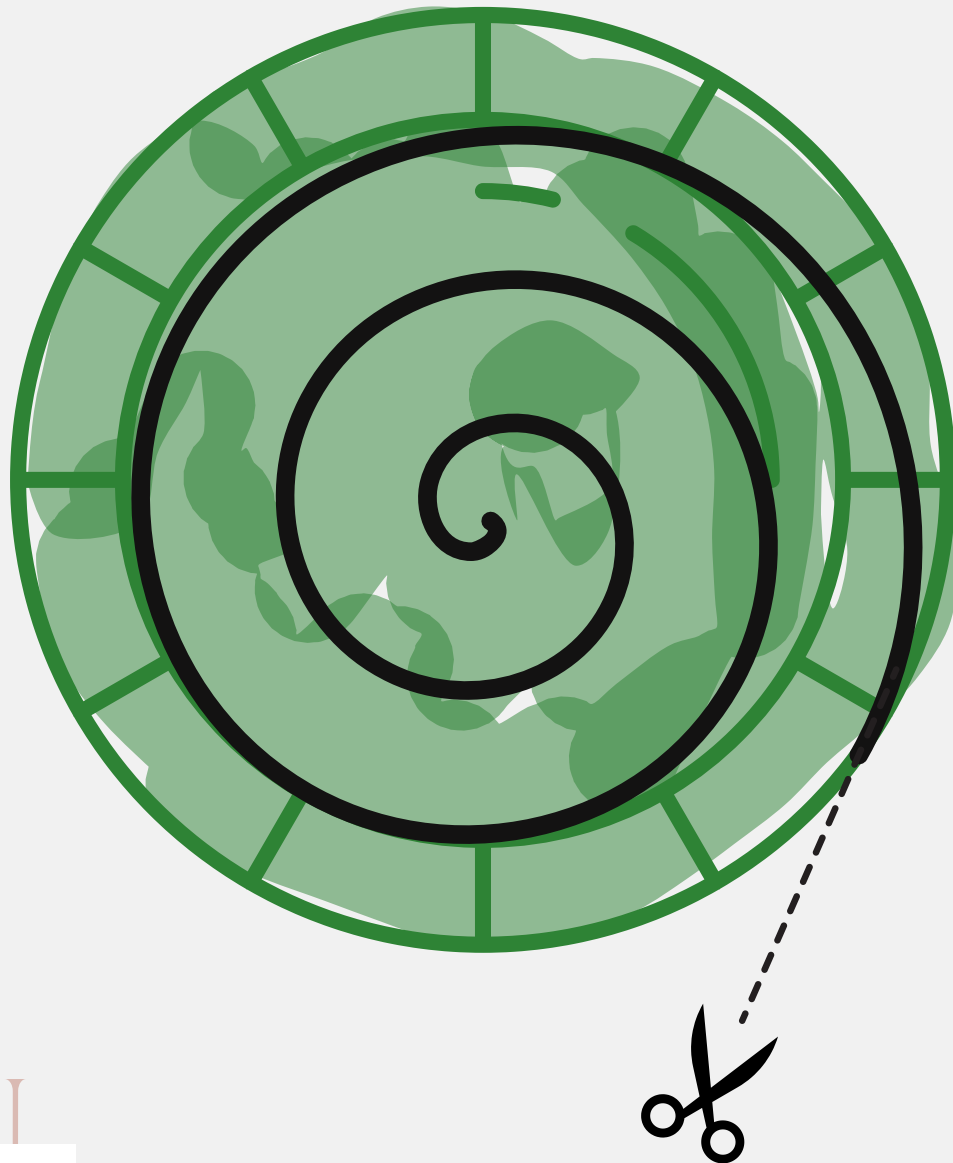
Step 2

Draw a spiral on the paper plate.



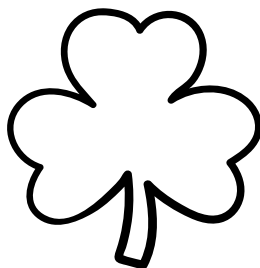
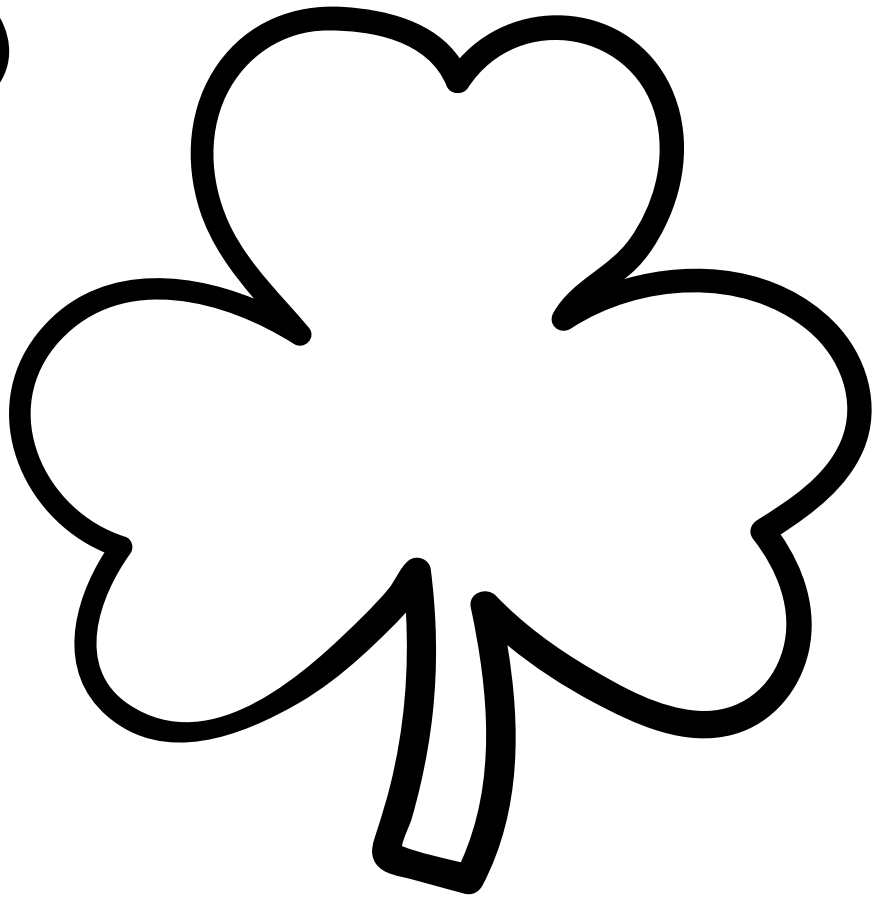
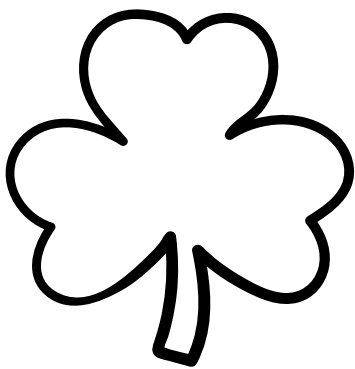
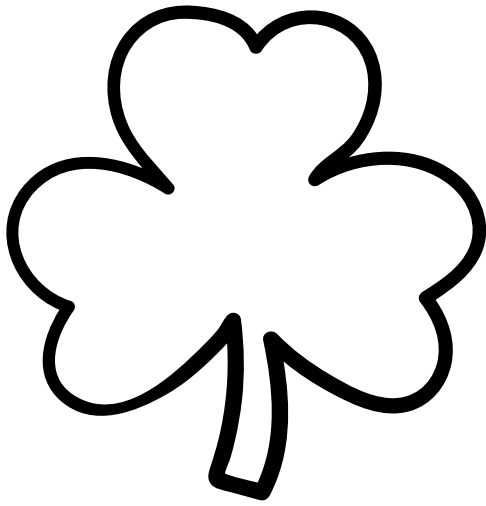
Step 3

Cut along the spiral line.



Step 4

- Print + cut out shamrock shapes and use them as stencils on construction paper.
- Cut out the shamrocks you traced on the construction paper.
- You can also trace them onto white paper and color or paint them yourself.



Step 5

Once you have colored or painted your shamrock shapes, glue them onto the spiral cut paper plate.



Step 6

Add a hole at the top of the paper plate spiral using a hole punch and attach the string through the hole to hang it.



Step 7

Hang your twirler in a special place to add some St. Patrick's Day magic to your space.
